That toddling town, Chicago, is quite pleased that both the Chicago Cubs and the Chicago White Sox are in first place in their respective divisions. The Helpers in Chicago are also in first place in the hearts of all pro-lifers thanks to the efforts of their leader, Philip Moore. In May Philip arranged for Fr. Steven Lesniewski to come to Brooklyn for additional training. While there Fr. Steven witnessed a woman at the abortion business located at 14 DeKalb Avenue demanding that the police arrest the abortionist and the staff for killing black babies. According to the latest New York City official statistics, 7 out of every 10 unborn black babies are destroyed by abortion in Brooklyn. Matt and Georgene Ulrich have been faithfully praying and counseling at their local abortion facility in Seattle Washington for many years. Eighteen years ago I spoke with them and a friend of theirs who was an attorney. The attorney later became a priest, and led the last large prayer vigil held in Seattle. July, 2016 Jubilee Year of Mercy

Dear Friends of God's Precious Infants and Their Mothers,

Our Holy Father Pope Francis, during this Jubilee Year of Mercy, has asked all Catholics to reflect upon and increase both the corporal and spiritual works of mercy in their lives. The Helpers of God's Precious Infants are incorporating the spiritual works of mercy every time that they go to the modern day Calvary, their local abortion business. The spiritual works of mercy are: 1) Instructing the Ignorant – the Helpers sidewalk counselors offer information where help is available to pregnant women; 2) Counsel the Doubtful – the Helpers will talk and pray with vulnerable women who doubt they can cope with a pregnancy; 3) Admonish Sinners – the Helpers do this in a loving way so that the woman will never return to the abortion facility, even if she chooses to destroy her child; 4) Bear Wrongs Patiently – the Helpers are constantly being harassed by passersby and escorts frequently being recipients of "one-half of the peace sign" but do not confront those who do this; 5) Forgive Offenses Willingly – the Helpers are also at times subjected to physical abuse without complaint; 6) Comfort the Afflicted – the Helpers will also reach out to any woman who has aborted her child to comfort and console her in her time of need; 7) Pray for the Living and the Dead - Helpers prayer warriors are constantly praying for both the mother and her child, even if the child is not saved, the Helpers are praying for that child's soul. Many Helpers are also engaged with the corporal works of mercy, feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, clothing the naked, and sheltering the homeless when they open their hearts and wallets to help mothers who have decided for life.

TRIP TO FATIMA

On October 2, 2015 I flew into Lisbon airport accompanied by two Helpers from New York, Susan and Kevin Moore, to attend the five day World Prayer Congress for Life. We arrived at about 8:45AM local time and were met by a driver who proceeded to drive us to Fatima, about an hour and a half away. I arrived just in time to deliver my first talk with about 15 minutes to spare. It was quite difficult to speak in front of large crowd of people, especially after having almost no sleep the night before due to a medical problem of the person who sat next to me on the plane. Somehow God helped me to deliver the talk on facing the truth of the Culture of Death which was well received. At the Congress was a lively group of people from over 30 nations most of whom were there to report on what they were doing to advance the culture of life in their own countries. Later that day, after many of the attendees participated in the Way of the Cross in Aljustrel, (the site of Our Blessed Mother's apparition in 1917) I was the principal celebrant in a Mass of Reparation there.

The next day I offered Mass for English speaking pilgrims in the hotel that the conference was being held at, Domus Pacis Hotel. Many of the pilgrims visited the Carmelite convent in Coimbra where Sister Lucia, one of the visionaries, lived most of her life. We also were able to view the documentary "From Ocean to Ocean", a film about the travels of the image of Our Lady of Czestochowa all over the world and the many intercessions made for life by these travels.

On Sunday, October 4, I offered a workshop on the Helpers approach to sidewalk counseling which was well attended. I received many questions after the presentation which I was happy to answer. I was heartened to see many young people at this workshop. I was again able to offer Mass for English speaking people at Domus Pacis.

On Monday after I offered Mass at the hotel, we heard a powerful presentation by Rebecca Kiessling, who was conceived in rape, but whose life was spared due to the protective laws in place at that time. She urged us not to support any politician, who may declare himself pro-life, but who makes an exception in cases of rape and incest. We also heard from participants from 32 countries report on their activities for life. The overwhelming majority are using the Helpers approach to build a culture of life in their respective country. It was very encouraging to hear.
